Visual artist and Professor of Artistic Creation and Pictorial Techniques in the Faculty of Fine Arts at the University of Salamanca, as well as the Master in Advanced Studies in Artistic Production and Practices at the same University.

Graduated in Music History, Musical Harmony and Chamber Music, obtaining a degree in Piano and Accordion from the Conservatorio Superior de Música de Badajoz. 1988-2001

He recently exhibited at ART SUR in Montemayor (Córdoba), participating as personal assistant in the work of the prestigious Bavarian Land Art artist, Nils-Udo. 2023. A documentary produced by the University of Salamanca and the Centro de Arte Contemporáneo Medioambiental VALDELARTE, Huelva (Spain), which is currently in production, will be released at the end of 2023, about the author's artistic work, linking art-nature and territory, with interventions carried out in different natural spaces in the country during the last two years.
